George Norcross serves as Chairman of Conner Strong Companies, Inc. headquartered in Marlton, New Jersey. He has served in this position or with predecessor companies since 1979.

With Norcross serving as CEO, the company grew over a ten year period from the 58th largest U.S. brokerage with \$120 million in premium volume to the 23rd largest U.S. brokerage with over \$1 billion in premium volume.

Norcross is Chairman of the Board of Trustees for Cooper University Hospital in Camden, New Jersey and has served as Member of the Board of Trustees since 1990. During his tenure, Norcross was instrumental in transforming Cooper from a financially troubled institution into one of the top tier academic medical centers in the greater Philadelphia region. In 2006, he was recognized by the New Jersey Council of Teaching Hospitals as Trustee of the Year.

Norcross formerly served as Member of the Board of Directors of Commerce Bancorp, Inc. (NYSE:CBH).

Norcross is a long-time benefactor for the Larc School in Bellmawr, New Jersey, a special education school for children with disabilities. He was also the recipient of the 2nd Annual Champion of Children's Award in 2007 due to his commitment to making helping children a priority.

Norcross was an honoree of the Jewish National Fund and recipient of the Tree of Life Award in 2001 in recognition of his philanthropic and community leadership.
