Prepare Now to Protect Your Business

NOAA is forecasting the 2026 hurricane season to produce 8 to 14 named storms, including up to 3 major hurricanes. Now is the time to put a plan in place. Before any major hurricane, Conner Strong & Buckelew proactively reaches out to clients who may be impacted to help ensure they are prepared.

✓ BEFORE THE STORM

Establish an internal emergency response team

Assign clear roles and responsibilities to each member

Secure your property

Elevate items, secure outdoor objects, install shutters, and place sandbags at openings

Identify vendors

Connect with vendors who offer essential emergency services to ensure timely support

Connect with your broker

Plan for time to connect with your broker as they will reach out to arrange inspections, provide guidance, and ensure you are fully prepared

✓ DURING THE STORM

Shelter indoors

Remain in secure locations away from water and strong winds

Stay informed

Follow forecasts, as conditions can change rapidly, and impacts can be experienced deep inland

Follow official guidance

Limit non-essential operations, and if evacuation is required, use designated routes

✓ AFTER THE STORM

Protect your property

Prevent further damage by securing broken windows, covering torn roof areas, and inspecting and repairing drains, gutters, and flashing as needed

Engage emergency service vendors

Reach out to a loss remediation company if additional help is required

Document all damage

Assess property damage, take photographs and videos, and keep records of all expenses incurred

Report your claim

Promptly notify Conner Strong & Buckelew if you sustain a loss
